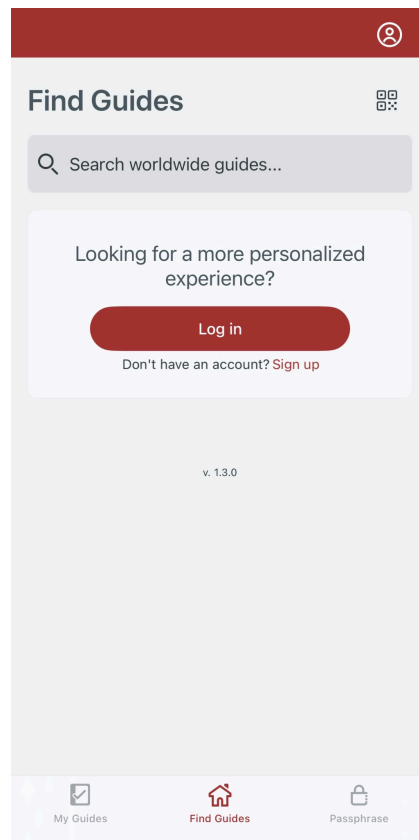

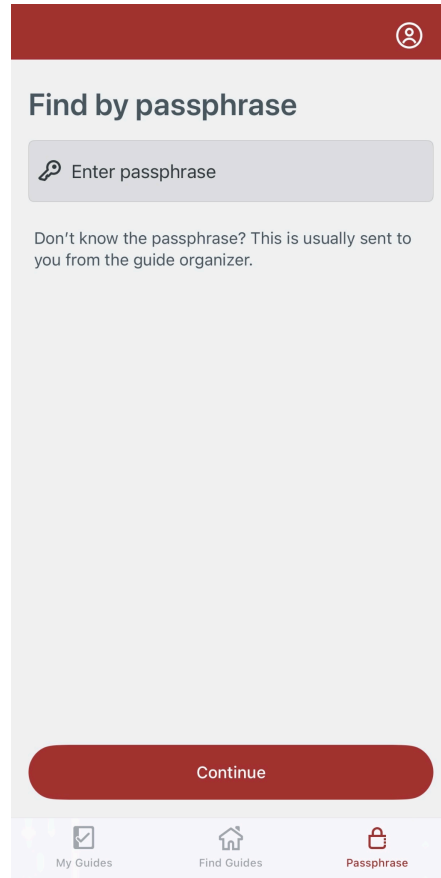

Once you've downloaded the app from either the App Store or Google Play store, you'll be taken to this page.

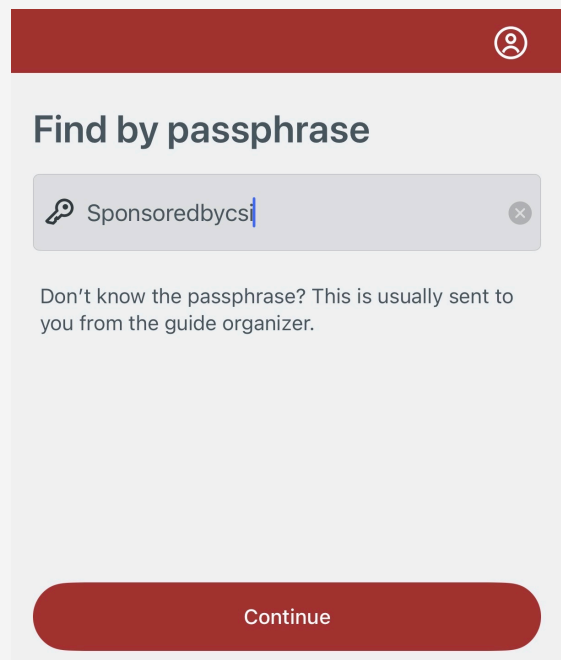




Click into the passphrase tab in the lower right corner.



Enter the passphrase **sponsoredbycsi** and click continue.



You'll then be prompted to download and open the 13th National Conference on Earthquake Engineering guide. You'll only need to do this action once.

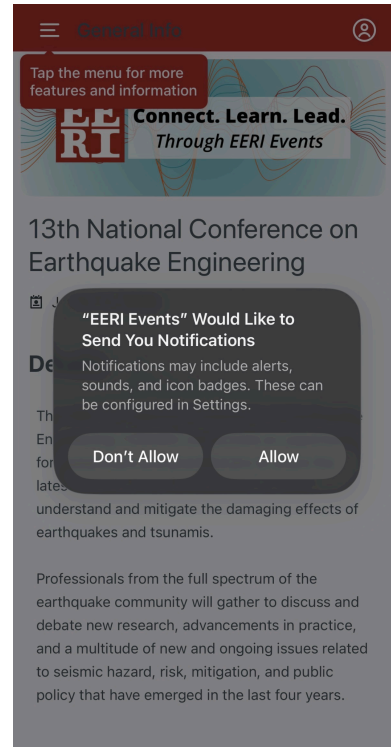

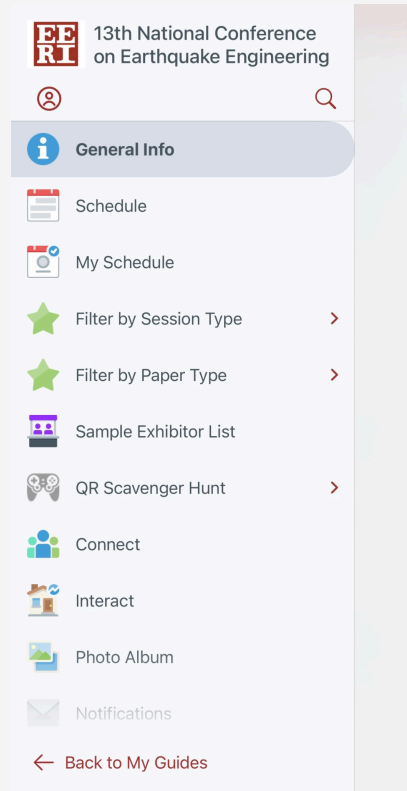
You'll be prompted to allow notifications from this event. We recommend clicking **Allow** to stay up to date with the latest information as the event is live.



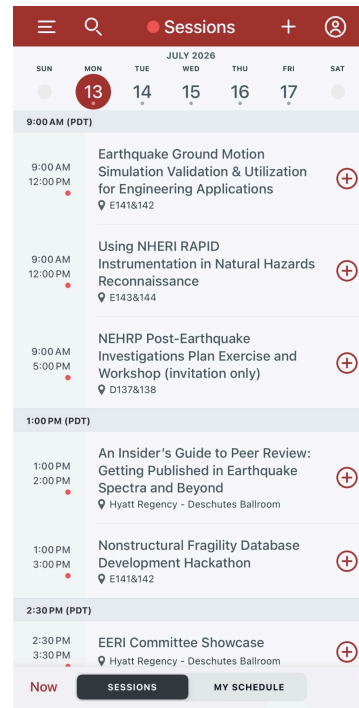
Click the three lines in the upper left corner to see the full menu.



Each menu item represents a feature within the app. Make sure to browse through all of the options before the conference begins.

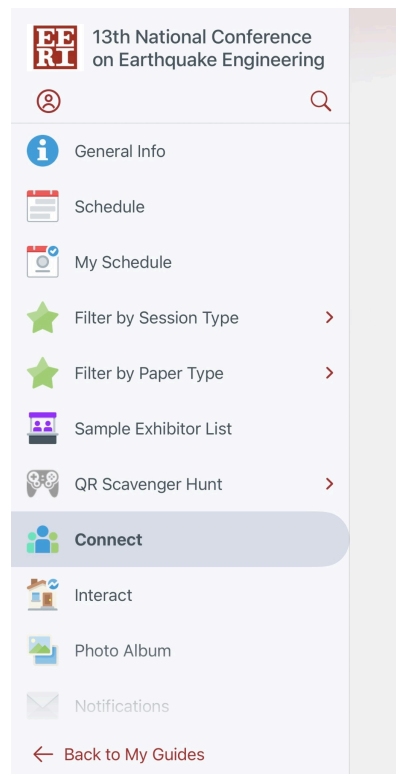

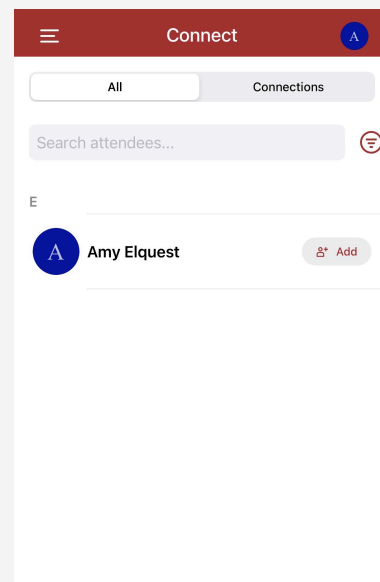


## Step 3 - Optional: Create an Account to Access the Connect Feature

There are some features in the app which will require an account. The first is “Connect,” our networking feature. You can find this in the main menu.



If you try to add a connection on this feature, you will be prompted to log in.



**Option 1:** Log in with an existing account

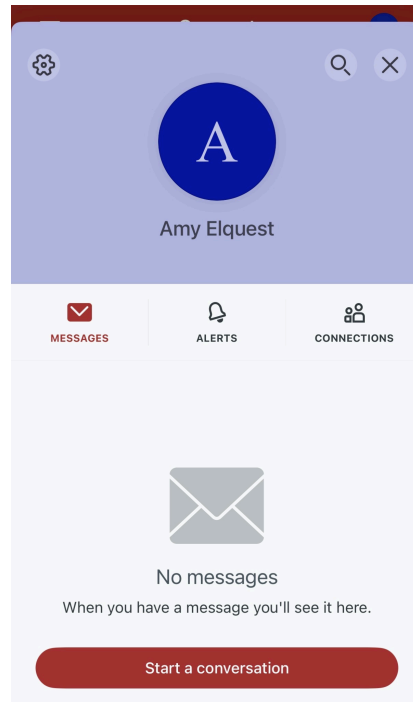
